The information below includes all the details of our curriculum and calendar. In reception the children will have daily maths, literacy and phonics lessons as well as accessing the continuous provision to access the rest of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. The children will have use of all 3 areas throughout the day (both indoors and outdoors).

Throughout the year the children have access to a rich and inspiring curriculum and will be assessed against 17 different Early Learning Goals-for any further information on this please speak to Mr Bromage at anytime.

English

We will be reading and exploring fairy tales and traditional tales as well as alternative versions eg Jim and The Beanstalk. We will act out and retell traditional tales with props and masks etc.

Mathematics

As a school we follow the Power Maths Scheme.

We follow Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Phonics scheme. In this half term we will be learning:

Graphemes: ff, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, sh, th, ng, nk Tricky words: as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, he, of, we, me, be





We will be thinking about the perspective of others. We will also be beginning to show an understanding of other people's feelings.

RE

As part of the Archdiocese of Birmingham we follow the curriculum 'Learning and Growing as the People of God'. This half term we will cover: People Who Care for Us Advent Christmas





In our theme of 'Who is afraid of the Big Bad Wolf?' we will be learning about different Traditional Tales. We will also be looking at different festivals such as Diwali and Bonfire Night.

Home learning

Children will also be sent home with reading books, phonemes (sounds) and words to learn. Please try and practise these daily for short periods of time. As always if you need any additional support with any of these tasks please don't hesitate to ask for some help or advice.

Children will also be sent a login to access some online reading books that will be inline with the phonics and reading lessons from each week.
