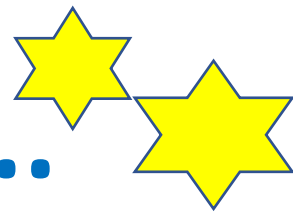
Family Information Service

The holiday activities and food (HAF) programme is for school aged children in full time education from reception to Year 11 (inclusive), who receive benefits related free school meals. The programme offers valuable support to families on lower incomes, giving young people the opportunity to access activities with a healthy meal provision over the main school holidays at Christmas, Easter and Summer..We work with local activity providers across Warwickshire to offer eligible families a holiday programme that has a variety of fun, engaging and enriching activities.
